CIRRUS SR20/SR22

We are anticipating having an Cirrus SR20 on our flightline in the near future, which will also be available for rent. The SR20 will be available for use as one of our primary training aircraft. The hourly rental cost is yet to be determined. The SR20 offers composite construction and advanced aerodynamics, incorporates flat-panel,

multi-function display technology and state-of-the-art safety innovations, including a final level of safety known as the Cirrus Airframe Parachute System (CAPS). Through composite construction, Cirrus achieves exacting engineering specifications and produces aerodynamically superior shapes. With minimal seams and a low-drag surface, our aircraft can reach higher

cruise speeds using a fuel-efficient engine, even with fixed gear and one of the widest cabins in its class. We added more speed and performance to the SR20's formidable flying qualities and created our next generation model, the SR22, which was FAA certified in 2000. An Cirrus SR22 will be on display at the Open House and will be joining our flight line by Fall of this year.
